

# 2008 Pheasant Stocking Information

The Department no longer publishes the *Special Pheasant Hunting Regulations*. Regulations related to pheasant hunting can be found within the *2008 Small Game Hunting Regulations*. This publication contains a listing of public hunting grounds that may be stocked with pheasants this fall. The Department plans to stock 70 public hunting grounds with approximately 52,000 game farm pheasants during the 2008 fall pheasant season. Please note that this is a **preliminary** estimate and final numbers may be revised prior to release. Maps of selected public hunting grounds can be found on the website at [dnr.wi.gov](http://dnr.wi.gov) or by visiting your local DNR Service Center. Before hunting pheasants on public hunting grounds, be sure to check the regulations for special requirements that apply including 2pm closure areas and hen-rooster hunting. Please remember that a **pheasant stamp is required statewide!** Additional pheasant hunting opportunities are provided through conservation clubs enrolled in the Day-old Chick (DOC) program. These clubs raise and release pheasants on private land open to public hunting or on approved state-owned lands. Hunters are reminded to be polite and ask permission before hunting on private property open to public hunting as part of the DOC program.
